ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2008 - 2009.

From the Desk of the Managing Trustee:

I am very happy to bring out the following Annual Report of our Trust and praise God for all HIS Mercies:

1. This is the 15th subsequent year of 100% pass-out of our students. All our 127 children are promoted to higher classes with good marks.
2. Most of our children stood 1st to 6th ranks in their classes.
3. 5 children are going to finish their University Degree Examination.
4. 2 girls are going to complete their Assistant Nursing and Midwifery Course.
5. 3 girls are going to finish their General Nursing Course (3 years Diploma Course). Out of these 3 girls Neela stood first and received 'The best out going student Award' of the Institution,
6. Kayal Vizhi of 2nd year Junior College staying in Gell Memorial Girls School stood first in the Oratorical competition conducted by the Government in the District level and second in the State level. She received a shield and a cash award of INR 8,000/=.
7. Jude Kirubakaran secured 96% marks in his Degree examination and became the University Rank Holder. Government of Tamil Nadu has sanctioned INR 2,00,000/- as a interest free loan for his Master Degree of Higher Studies. This amount can be repaid when he gets a job after his studies. Now he is going to join in Bishop Heeber's College at Trichy town.
8. To encourage the children, Fr. Nathaniel's Charitable Trust sponsored rolling cups and shields in seven different Schools for the 'Best Out-going Students'.
9. Ramya Princes, Jothilakshimi, Kayal Vizhi, Sheeba, Sandhiya and Vanitha of Junior College, Seevanthi, Suganya, Suja, Lakshimi and Saranya of Standard X, Rajeswari and Sujitha of Standard IX, Evu Evangelin, Kalaiyarasi and David Arputharaj of Standard VIII, Ramya and Aruna of Standard VII were stood first rank throughout the year in different Schools. They were awarded Medals and Certificates by the Trust.
10. 57 deserving children were given Scholarships during this year.
11. 3 girls are going to finish Computer Course successfully.
12. More than 20 children, mostly girls are going for their higher education and technical training this year.
13. Priyanka of 3 years and Thomas Patrick of 5 years lost their parents and became orphans were taken under our care.
14. 2 of our orphan children got married this year. The Trust took all the steps to find their life partners and now they are leading a happy life.
15. 8 poor children were taken from the streets and hotels, are now under our care at Annai Illam, Trichy. Our main policy is to fight against child labour.
16. Few poor women were given financial assistance to earn their own bread by purchasing few goats.

17. More than 24 awareness programmes were conducted in different villages about HIV, Child Labour, Education and Women Development.
18. Shanmugam of 78 years and William of 84 years died in our Aged Home this year. We had a grand burial Service.

I take this opportunity to thank all our Staff, Volunteers and the Well-wishers of this Charitable Institution, who worked very hard to bring-up these marvelous achievements. I also congratulate all children who have performed well during the last years and all the credit goes to them.
