Child Care

Fr. Nathaniel's Charitable Trust is a shelter and a nest for many destitute people all these years. This year 198 poor children were under our care in different institutions.

Rejoice with me that all our children have promoted to higher classes and this is the 22nd subsequent year of 100% results of our students.

Many of our children are the class toppers.



The Fruits

5 children have successfully finished their education and they will colorfully fly off to earn their own bread. Though the departing time is very sad, we are very proud and happy that this home has given recognition in the society to stand on their own leg.

Evu Evangline stood first in her department and she is been placed in a private School as an English teacher in Ooty.



Higher Education

20 children are stepping in to the college to do their degree courses. Apart from these children 6 more children are studying their degree courses in different colleges Asrina Ferwin, Anitha, and Johnson stood first in their subjects.



Nursing

This year 3 girls have finished their nursing training and they have been placed in different hospitals as nurses, at present 5 girls are doing their B.sc Nursing in that Sathya Priya stood first in the college. It is an-other feather in our cap.



Vocational Training

16 unprivileged young girls are trained in the tailoring and embroidery course in remote and neglected places in Nilgiris.



Junior College

24 of our children have successfully finished their Junior College, out of this R Deepak, stood school first in the school. 19 children have scored distinction. It was a proud movement to see our children getting crown in their studies.





High School

15 of our children have successfully finished their high school with good marks and joining Junior College. Shalini Saravanan Stood school first and 11 of them have got distinction in the final year high school examination.

23 of our children are going to the final year high school this year.



Awards

To encourage the children, we sponsor rolling cups and shields in seven different Schools for the "Best Out-going Students"

70 of our children have got awards and prizes in athletic and sports. 109 of our children have got special award for their 100% attendance during this academic year. Nandhini, Subashini and Tamilarasi won the district level hand ball and basketball competition. Omprakash and Jenifer Gloriya won the best cardets award in the School NCC.



Scholarships

55 deserving children were given Scholarships to continue their studies.

9 children have been rescued from child labour and now they are happily going to school.



5 deserving boys were given vocational training.

Counselling

Value added education and awareness programme have been hosted in 5 different schools by Isaac.

Children and youth counselling were effectively been done and many children are using this facility. We have saved few people's life and changed thier views towards life.
